Notice of Race

The Organizing Authority is Royal Danish Yacht Club- KDY - in conjunction with the International 12mR class Association (ITMA)

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, except if changed by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 The applying prescriptions of the Nordic Sailing Federation and the Danish Sailing Association will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 Appendix T – Arbitration will apply.
- 1.4 Standard rule changes occur in some of the instructions.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open for all 12mR, holding valid Measurement Certificates. The 12mR fleet will sail for Wessel & Vett Cup based on the ITMA rule, all division are eligible, and prizes will be awarded in all Division with at least 3 participants.
All 12mR will also sail for the 12mR Trophy based on the Baltic Handicap system.
- 3.2 Qualified boats may enter by sending an email to patrick@howaldt.dk the before July 15th 2019.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Entry fees: The fee is DKK 1,100 per person (skippers, crew, spouses etc.) The fee includes access for all social activities mentioned in the schedule below, breakfast is offered at the Club Restaurant a lunch bags for each of the race days can be ordered at "KDY" Club restaurant, if we get at least 70 participants signing up to it. The breakfast will cost 85 DKK per person and day, for 125 DKK per person you get breakfast and the ability to produce lunch packs at the Club restaurant. Please let Patrick Howaldt know about your choice.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

Thursday	Sept. 5 th	16.00 – 18.00 19.00	Registration Opening reception with grill at Club Station of the Royal Danish Yacht Club in Skovshoved
Friday	Sept 6 th .	09.00 10.30 19.00	Skippers Briefing Earliest warning signal 1 st race for the day (4 races planned) Dinner venue to be communicated
Saturday	Sep 7 st	10.30 After 2.or 3.up/down race 19.00	Earliest warning signal for the race of the day (2-3 race planned) Departure from the race area for Start to the distance race through the inner Copenhagen Harbor Dinner venue to be communicated
Sunday	Sep 8 th	10.30	Earliest warning signal 1 st race for the day (3 races planned) Prize giving ceremony

5.1 Up to 10 races are scheduled for the Wessel & Vett Cup. The Cup will be awarded if at least 4 races will be completed.

The distance race on Saturday will not be included in the Cup Series, but will be a separate race with a separate prize

5.2 After finishing a race, a new race will start shortly after.

5.3 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 14.30 o'clock.

6 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and present it at registration. The organizing committee reserves the right to conduct measurement checks before, during or after any race.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration in the regatta office at the club house of the KDY Station in Skovshoved.
- 7.2 Separate Sailing Instructions for the distance race on Saturday Sept.7th. will be available at registration.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 The regatta venue will be at the Skovshoved Harbour
- 8.2 Race courses will be East of Skovshoved

9 THE COURSE

The courses will be "Windward/Leeward courses"

10 SCORING

- 10.1
 - a) The special 12mR-Scoring-System will apply.
 - b) Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a valid championship. When 4 or more races have been completed, the worst score will be excluded.

- 10.2 There will be scoring based on the 12mR rule and a separate scoring based on the Baltic 12mR handicap system. The boats handicaps and the rating system will be described in a notice to the competitors that will be published on the notice board.

11 MOORING AND HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 11.1 All yachts must be moored at the designated berths in Skovshoved. Free mooring is available from September 3rd. to September 10th.
- 11.2 Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta from 08.00 o'clock on the first racing day until the last boat finishes the last race, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the organizing committee.

12 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around the boats from 08:00 Hrs. on the first racing day until the last boat finishes the last race.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The race committee will use VHF Radio for communication to the fleet regarding the start and other race management issues. Apart from this a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

The 12mR class will be sailing for the Alfred Benzon Trophy on scratch and the 12mR Trophy based on the Baltic Fleet handicap System.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
